

Remote Learning Year 1 to Year 6

Dear Parents,

Thank Enforced temporary closure is now unavoidable for BGS. Our Business Continuity Plan meant that we had planned work for the next fortnight leading up to the Easter holiday starting Friday 3rd April 2020 should this be the mandate. Your children will be educated via work pack that will be sent home beginning Monday 23rd March 2020, via email from their class teachers. Children will also be given a home learning pack containing blank excersise books, folders for storage of work and a helpful upto date copy of staff contact emails. Thank you for supporting them during this period.

We have been investigating the possibility of using Google Classroom as a medium/long term means of virtual communication for sharing work, planning, resources and monitoring. In order to do this we will first require some help from you as parents. Thank you in advance.

Every child from Year 1 - Year 6 must have a Gmail account. As a safeguarding measure, because children are learning remotely, we require your parental input and supervision. Please visit

www.gmail.com to begin creating your child's account.

Ideally the prefix of the account will be something easy for the child to remember. It may be seen by virtual classmates and teachers. We suggest: Timothy Davis would appear bgstimothyd2020@gmail.com (school, first name, first letter of surname, year of account set up). Please get as close to this as possible.

Note that access to Google Classrooms will only be possible when we have received everybody's reply and have registered every pupil. I will then be able to respond with a welcome email where your child will be invited to join their virtual Google Classroom.
